

Once we landed in Bacolod, we were met by Pastor Jun and his wife, Juvi, as well as a fellow American Missionary, Nathan Goodpaster and his daughter (the Goodpasters minister about an hour from Haven of Grace). What a joyful reception! Once we finally made it back to Haven of Grace, the children from the surrounding village heard of our return, and came to greet our children the next day. Their reunion is one of the sweetest things I have ever seen.
